

Satellite Phone Rental Companies

For extreme outdoor adventures that take you deep into Alaska backcountry, it is critical that you take a satellite phone as part of your communication and safety equipment.

Type of Satellite Phone to Rent-“Iridium”

It is first important to note that the only “reliable” satellite phone in the Northern Alaska Regions is an **Iridium Satellite Phone**. Do not rent any other type as it would be virtually useless.

Where to Rent a Satellite Phone

Iridium Satellite Phones can be rented online and in most communities and cities including Anchorage and Fairbanks Alaska.

There are many online companies that offer satellite phone rentals for quite reasonable prices. I suggest you Google and see what deals they have. They generally rent by the week and add more for additional days. Here is an example of one of those online companies:

If you choose to use a local vendor in your own community or city, I suggest that you do a Google search or check your yellow pages.
